### **RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

- Competition is composed of two categories: Closed Sorsogon Province and Open Bicol Region Only.
- 2. The competition is open to all Dancesport couple/enthusiasts with at least:

7-12 yrs. old – Juvenile Category (Bonafide Sorsoganon Only) 13-17 yrs. old – Junior Category (Bonafide Sorsoganon Only)

18-40 yrs. old - Open category

- 3. The couple will be required to submit certified photocopy of Authenticated or Civil Registrar's Issued Birth Certificate.
- 4. The discipline of the dance is Latin American (Cha-cha-cha, Samba, Rumba, Jive and Paso Doble)

Juvenile C - (Samba, Cha-cha-cha, Jive)

Junior B - (Cha-cha-cha, Rumba, Jive, Samba)

Open A – (Cha- cha- cha, Rumba, Samba, Jive, Paso-doble)


- 5. Lifts are not permitted in any category, level and dance. A lift is any movement during which one member of a couple has both feet off the floor at the same time with the assistance of the partner and the Tournament Manager with the signal of the Chairman of the Board of Adjudicators will DISQUALIFY couples who will perform lifts during the competition.
- 6. Competitors shall dress according to the given dress code and regulations of the organizers. Each athlete may change costumes up to 3 time from the first round to the final round provided such costume has passed the screening of costumes and competition attires set by the Tournament Manager.
  - 6.1. Juvenile and Junior (Closed Costume)
  - 6.2. Open category (Open Costume).
- 7. The couples will be disqualified if the proper dress regulations, rules and guidelines are not followed.
- 8. There will only be fifteen (15) slots for each category.
- 9. The organizer will provide the official music for the competition.
- 10. Registration is FREE.
- 11. Registration for two categories is not allowed.
- 12. The organizers are not accountable for any liabilities, claims for injury, physical damages and losses suffered by competing couple during the rehearsal and competition proper.
- 13. The decision of adjudicators is final and no communication will be entertained.
- 14. All person present at the championship, whether as competitor, spectators, officials or guest shall be bound by these terms and conditions and their presence automatically agree to adhere them.
- 15. Rehearsal schedule: June 19, 2024, 9:00 A.M @ Sorsogon Provincial Gymnasium
- 16. Competition date: June 19, 2024, 1 P.M. onwards.



### 1<sup>ST</sup> GAYON CIUDAD DLC COMPETITION 2024

### **General Guidelines:**

- 1. The competition is open to all public and private secondary schools within Sorsogon Province. (14 municipalities, 1 city).
- 2. Participants are expected to be at the venue on June 24, 2024 (Sorsogon Capitol Compound-assembly area for the parade) before 7:00 am, complete and prepared for the parade and opening program. (Sorsogon Sports Arena)
- 3. Props and other materials brought to the venue are teams' responsibilities. The organizers/City Government of Sorsogon is not liable to any loss or damage to such.
- 4. Food and transportation expenses of participants from private and public schools maybe charged to school MOOE. The organizers will provide a sponsored lunch during the said event.
- 5. There will only be 15 official contingents: FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS. The DLC banner/tarp will be provided by the organizer/City Government of Sorsogon.

### **Entry Criteria:**

- 1. All members of the DLC should be 12 years old and above.
- 2. There is only 1 category for this competition: Secondary
- 3. Contingents must be from the fourteen (14) municipalities and one (1) city in the Province of Sorsogon.
- 4. You can request entry/registration form/s from this email address: hagosojos.ian@gmail.com
- 5. Waiver and Release of Liability: Each member of DLC respectively must submit a "Waiver of Release and Liability" as attached to the entry forms. This is to waive the liability of the organizing committee for any accident or injury occurring to a group member prior to, during, or after the competition.
- 6. Each DLC contingent should submit their entry (including the names of DLC members) on or before June 10, 2024; 5:00 pm at Sorsogon City Tourism Culture and the Arts Office at Sorsogon Rompeolas, Talisay, Sorsogon City. Entry form is provided at the annex of this ground rules. Entry form must be signed by the DLC Adviser with attached passport size photo and Letter of Intent signed by the School Principal.



7. Failure to comply with all the necessary requirements before the imposed final deadline by the organizers will automatically forfeit their participation.

### Composition

- 1. Competing teams should be composed of a minimum of forty (40) members, with 80 as a maximum number of members.
- 2. Students who are fresh graduates (Grade 10 and Grade 12) are still allowed to join the competition. But incoming Grade 7 students will be allowed provided that they submit a photocopy of their approved enrollment form.
- 3. Team members should be a Bonafede members of the school Drum and Lyre Band from the fourteen (14) municipalities and one (1) city.
- 4. Keyboard percussions/Pit sections such as (gong, timpani, cymbals, concert bass, vibraphone, marimba, table lyre, etc.) are allowed to be used/play.

### **Equipment and Props**

- 1. Equipment and piano keyboards that run on electricity are not allowed.
- 2. Marching players can only use any percussion equipment such as Marching Lyres, Upright lyre, Tenor Drum, Bass Drum, Snare and Marching Cymbals. Festival drums are not allowed.
- 3. All color guard equipment (Standard, oversized, giant, t-flags, sabers, rifles, air blades, baton, etc.) are allowed in the competition.
- 4. Structural props such as Backdrops, Front drops, etc. are allowed but movable props that the team will use to elevate players from the ground like stage, podium and scaffolding/s are only allowed with the maximum height of 6ft. only.



### Presentation

- 1. The competition will be held on June 24, 2024, 9:00 o clock in the morning at the Sorsogon Sports Arena, Sorsogon City. The parade will start at exactly 7:20 am. Assembly starting point at the Capitol and will end at Sorsogon Sports Arena.
- 2. Music shall include any songs that represent the vibe, rhythm and identity of each team/contingent or the festive celebration of Gayon Ciudad Festival.
- 3. Each team shall have a performance time of not less than 7 minutes and not more than 10 minutes and a 3-minute set-up with a total of 15 minutes including entry and exit.
- 4. Show performance will start and end with a courtesy salute.
- 5. One point will be deducted for every 10 seconds of presentation exceeding time allotment.
- 6. During the official performance all props will only be moved and utilized by the members only. Props men may only help in setting up the props but utilization of the props during the routine shall be strictly conducted by the performers only. 3 points will be deducted to the total average points of each contingent found violating this rule.
- 7. Dangerous props like open flames, pets, liquids, glass, fireworks or other forms of pyrotechnics; fuel-fire torches; candles; dangerous or live weapons or similar devices are highly prohibited. 2 points will be deducted to the average points of each contingent.
- 8. Costumes may vary on participants desire as long as they are appropriate, decent, and not vulgar. Type A uniform is highly recommended.
- 9. One (1) point will be deducted for the use of any violations per equipment and props.
- 10. Observe landscape formation for final presentation of exhibition.
- 11. Final blocking/formation of all contingents will be on June 23, 2024, from 1 to 5pm.First come, first serve.
- 12. The photoshoot/video shoot of Majorettes and Band leaders will be on June 10,2024 at 8:00 am. Venue: Sorsogon Sports Arena.
- 13. Order of presentation will be done through drawing of lots during the final meeting of coaches on June 10, 2024.



### **Criteria for Judging**

1. MUSIC (50%)

HARMONY AND RHYTMN: (Music arrangement, drum rudiments, composition)

- 2. VISUAL (50%)
  - A. Visual analysis for majorette/color guard: 30%
  - B. General visual effects: 10%
     (drill design, transitions, precision, choreography, marching cadence)
  - C. Uniform: 10% (appropriateness)

**TOTAL: 100%** 

For matters of due cause for challenge and protest, the teams should raise such within
 45 minutes before the judges' verdict for the finality.

#### **PRIZES:**

Champion / 1st place - (prize amounting to Php 100,000.00) + plaque of appreciation and certificate

1st runner up / 2nd place - (prize amounting to Php 75,000.00) + plaque of appreciation and certificate

2nd runner up / 3rd place - (prize amounting to Php 50,000.00) + plaque of appreciation and certificate

Consolation prizes for non-winning contingent: Php 15,000
