**Turn Over and Sustained Utilization of the ABC+ Beginning Reading
Program Materials/ BRP Videos**

1. In September 2023, the “Madya na, Mabarasa Kita” Package was handed over to Batch 1 recipients including select schools from this Division, namely Magallanes North CS, Caditaan ES, Dinapa ES, , Pilar I CS, Tingco ES, and Quidlog ES.
2. The package consists of 10 tablets with 12 videos for teaching beginning reading in Central Bikol with 50L Mega Box as container, a USB and consumable items such as pencil, ruler, plastic envelop and the like. The utilization of said materials can be maximized even during Catch Up Fridays.
3. The school-recipients represented by the school head and coordinator, together with the Public Schools District Coordinator/ OIC PSDS attended an orientation on the guidelines and utilization of the said package where primarily, the information that after 90 days, the next school recipient shall have been identified in consultation/ coordination with the concerned Public Schools District Supervisor.
